Subject: The European Union REACH Regulation

Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 on the Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) is in effect in European Union (EU) and European Economic Area (EEA) countries. The regulation places responsibility on businesses to demonstrate that chemicals they produce, use, and sell in significant quantities are safe for humans and the environment. Laird Technologies has assessed its responsibilities under REACH and, to the best of our knowledge at this time, believe we are in full compliance with the regulation.

Regarding Substances of Very High Concern (SVHCs), Article 33(1) of REACH stipulates that EU or EEA suppliers of articles that contain substances on the Candidate List in a concentration above 0.1% (w/w) must provide information on those substances, which are available to them, to their customers upon request and to other stakeholders within 45 days of the receipt of a request. This information should contain the name of the substance and guidance to ensure safe use of the article.

The officially published, current Candidate List containing the listed 84 SVHCs as of June 18, 2012 is available at:

Based on information currently available to Laird Technologies, the articles manufactured by our company which are sold in the EU and the EEA do not contain any of the currently listed 84 SVHCs in an amount exceeding the 0.1% (w/w) threshold specified in Article 33(1). Laird Technologies will continue to work with our suppliers to address REACH compliance and support implementation of the regulation.
