US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) regulation 40 CFR Part 751 TSCA Section 6

Eaton Bussmann business unit is aware of the importance of the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) regulation 40 CFR Part 751, Regulation of Certain Chemical Substances and Mixtures under Section 6 of the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA), these rules went into effect on February 5th, 2021 which regulates the manufacture, import, processing, distribution in commerce, use, or disposal and recordkeeping of five Persistent Bioaccumulative and Toxic (PBT) chemical substances and mixtures that may be contained in products or articles in the USA. These chemicals are:

- Decabromodiphenyl ether (DecaBDE, CAS: 1163-19-5)
- Phenol, isopropylated phosphate (3:1) (PIP 3:1, CAS: 68937-41-7)
- 2,4,6-Tris(tert-butyl)phenol (2,4,6-TTBP, CAS: 732-26-3)
- Hexachlorobutadiene (HCBD, CAS: 87-68-3)
- Pentachlorothiophenol (PCTP, CAS: 133-49-3)

Products below comply with the requirements of US EPA regulation 40 CFR TSCA section 6 "relating to restrictions on the marketing and use of certain dangerous chemicals" DecaBDE-Prohibited, PIP (3:1)-Prohibited, HCBD-Prohibited, 2,4,6-TTBP ($\leq 0.3\%$), PCTP ($\leq 1\%$).
