The US Environmental Protection Agency issued five final rules on January 6, 2021, to reduce exposures to certain chemicals that are persistent, bioaccumulative and toxic (PBT).

This is to inform you that STMicroelectronics International N.V. ("ST") is aware of the projected timetable to comply with the above-mentioned final rules, including the No Action Assurance until September 4, 2021.

2,4,6-tris(tert-butyl)phenol (2,4,6-TTBP)
Hexachlorobutadiene (HCBD)
Pentachlorothiophenol (PCTP)
